

Cost

An annual non-refundable \$50 registration fee is charged to all students. This fee covers registration, starting costs and insurance. The registration fee will be waived if the year tuition is paid in full at registration. The first month's tuition is due 1 month prior to the first class.

2/3 Year Old Program- \$115/month

3/4 Year Old Program- \$145/month

Pre-K Program- \$185/month

All Day Pre-K at Falls- \$390/month

All Day Care at Falls- \$165/week

All monthly tuition is due on the 1st of the month. Please be prompt in all payments or a \$10 late fee will be applied to the following month's payment. Every effort will be made to work with families to accommodate tuition payments. There is a \$25 charge for all bounced checks.

There is no reduction of fees for absenteeism, vacations, holidays or school closings due to circumstances beyond the control of the Little Feet Preschool.

Families with more than one child attending Little Feet Preschool may apply for a 10% discount on the lowest tuition. Request must be made in writing to the directors.

Philosophy

Educational Program

Themes and study units are child-centered through group circle time, individual learning experiences, small group and one-on-one teacher/student time, large motor experiences, computers, and ever-changing classroom learning centers.

Small motor development is based upon the Handwriting Without Tears® philosophy. HWT is a developmentally based, multi-sensory teaching approach developed by Jan Z. Olsen OTR.

Music will be offered on a weekly basis for a half hour. Teachers will also incorporate music on a daily basis. Little Feet believes that all learning for young children should incorporate fun.

School Hours

Little Feet Preschool is in operation September through May following the calendar of the Carroll County Public Schools. Exceptions to the public school year are noted in our yearly Preschool calendar. For inclement weather closings/delays we follow decisions made by the Carroll County Public School System.

Admission

Enrollment is open to students meeting the age requirements for the class for which they are applying. To be admitted to the 2/3 Year Old Program a child must be 2 by September 1, 2012. In order to be admitted to the 3/4 Year Old Program a child must be 3 by September 1, 2012.

Both your registration form and fee must be turned in before your spot is reserved. All required health forms will be sent out in July and are to be turned in by the first day of your child's class.

Current Little Feet Families have priority for enrollment until February 1st. After that point, classes are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Other applicants receive priority as of the date they pre-register or are placed on a waiting list.
